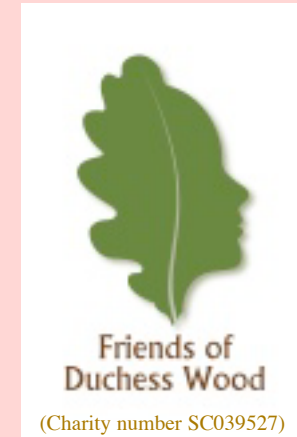

Fungi Checklist for Duchess Wood
