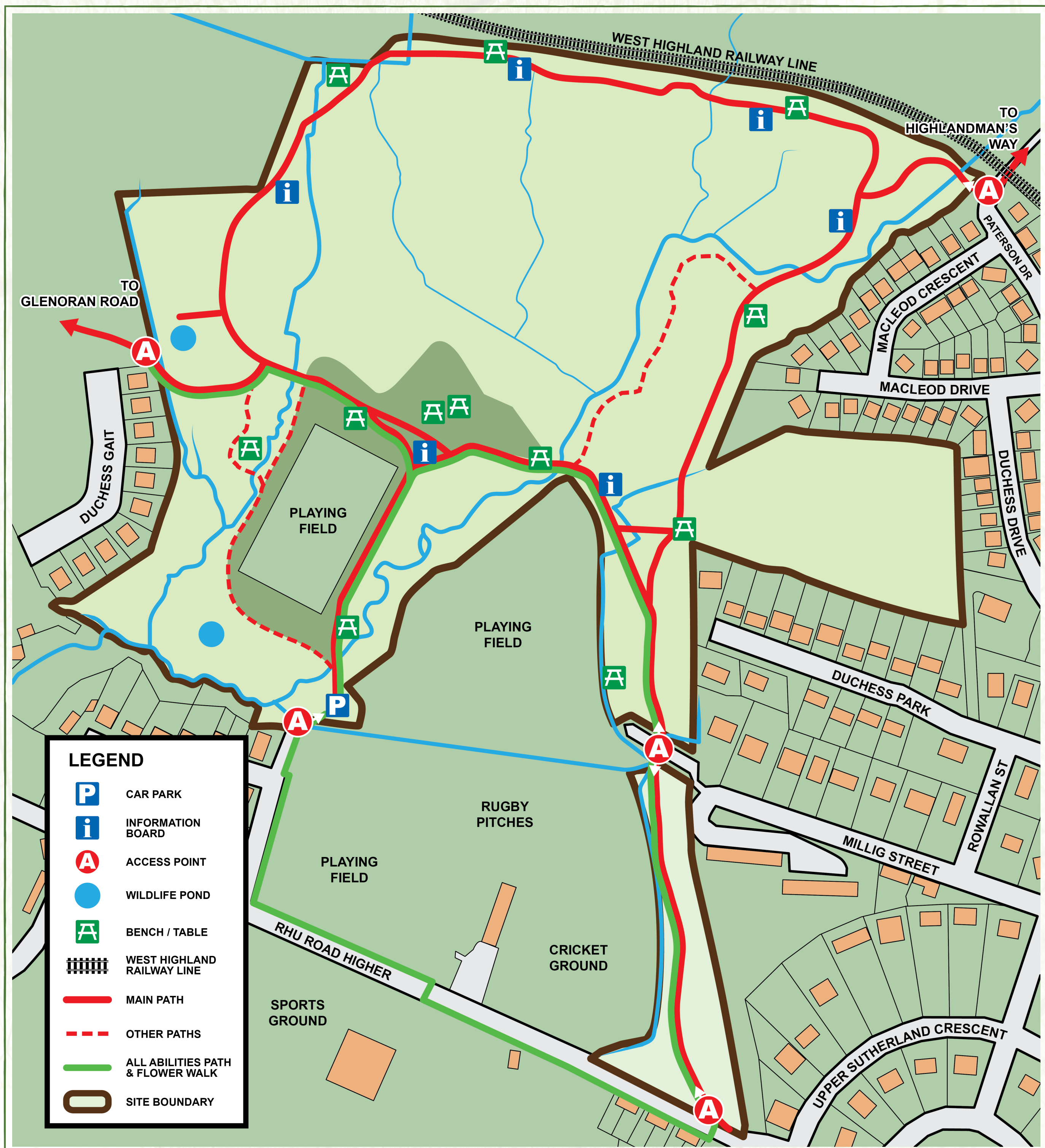

## Advice for visitors

- Please comply with the Scottish Outdoor Access Code and respect the interests of others.
- Leave no litter, and do not light fires.
- Keep your dog under control and clean up after it - bins are provided at the main entrances.
- The Wood is a natural area with fallen trees, steep banks and open edges, water and mud. Bear this in mind, especially when walking with children, but use the Wood to build an understanding of natural play. Please keep to the main paths around the wood.
- Cycling is permitted but cyclists should moderate their speed and take into account the heavy use of the Wood by pedestrians.
- Motorised vehicles are not permitted apart from mobility scooters or those associated with the management of the Wood.
